Each year the lives of thousands of men, women, and children are saved or greatly improved through transplantation. The true heroes behind this are the donors who gave the gift of life and the families who made it possible. Words cannot express the gratitude of those whose lives have been helped.

The Donor Memorial was created to honor donors and their generous gifts to others. The Memorial encompasses the bronze “Gift of Life” donor medal in its’ design, depicting the many gifts that one person is able to give to others through donation. The medal is mounted on a 7 foot granite monolith with an inscription of its meaning. Two granite benches have also been installed for families and others who visit the memorial.



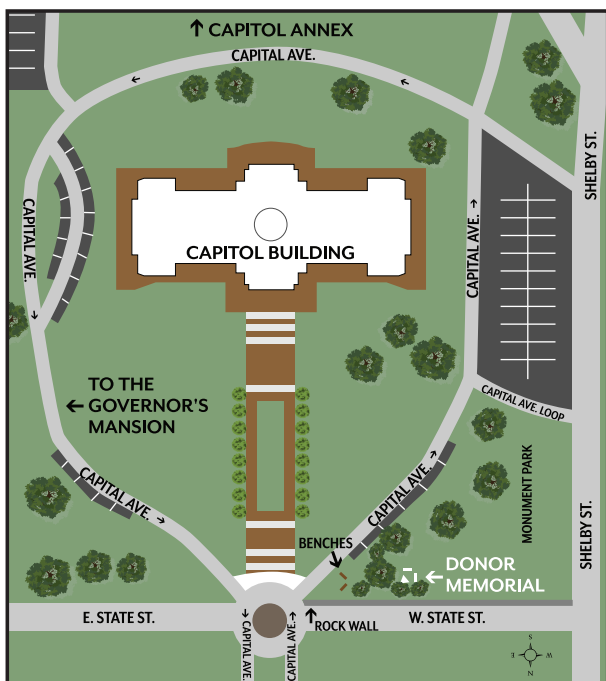

The Donor Memorial is in Monument Park, to the right as you look up at the Capitol Rotunda, behind the benches and stone wall. There are trees all around the Donor Memorial.
